Why am I receiving this questionnaire?

Your school is part of the Kent and Medway Progression Federation. You can read about KMPF at: www.kmpf.org

Your school works closely with local universities and colleges. You have been invited by your school to take part in activities that will help you understand what it is like to study a higher education course at a university or college. Higher education level courses are after A level, IB, BTEC and NVQ3. There are no right or wrong answers to these questions and we'd like to know what you think to help us with research.

Who are KMPF?

KMPF is a partnership between Canterbury Christ Church University, the University of Kent and over 40 schools in Kent and Medway. Canterbury Christ Church University looks after your personal data.

How do you use my data?

We store your data on a database called HEAT (Higher Education Access Tracker). You can read about it here: www.heat.ac.uk. We use the information you provide to follow your progress through education.

The HEAT database is kept on safe computer systems. Only people with the correct level of permission can view your information on the database. You can read about how we look after your data here:

How long will you keep my data?

We will keep your data for a long time. This is between 15 and 20 years. We need it for this time so that we can see if you decide to go to university in the future. You can ask us to stop processing your data at any time. You can email office@kmpf.org or write to: Kent and Medway Progression Federation, North Holmes Road, Canterbury, CT1 1QU.

Will anyone else use my data?

Yes. We share your data with KMPF partners who use the HEAT database. KMPF has to agree who can use your data on HEAT. We may share your data with people who provide us with a service. We only use people we can trust.

We may share the data for research and monitoring purposes with other institutions. These include the Office for Students (OfS), Higher Education Statistics Agency (HESA) and the University and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS). You can read more here: www.heat.ac.uk

Why do you use my data?

We use your data to do something that the law allows us to do. This is in the public interest or so that Canterbury Christ Church University can do its official job. The Higher Education and Research Act 2017 asks us to help people who might not think about going to university and who are from groups who are under-represented.

Each year Canterbury Christ Church University agrees an Access and Participation Plan with the Office for Students. We use your data to understand how well this plan has worked.

Can I stop taking part in the research?

You can stop taking part in the research at any time. If you decide not to take part, tell your school, send an email to office@kmpf.org or write to Kent and Medway Progression Federation, North Holmes Road, Canterbury, CT1 1QU. We will then stop using your data.
